steps.

The new Fellow will wait in the
Ante-Chapel, to be led in by the
President.

As the organ plays, the President
and the new Fellow will walk into
the Chapel to await Admission by
the Master.

The Ceremony

The Master will say: *Welcome to this ceremony for the admission of a new Fellow.*

The President will introduce the new Fellow.

- (i) President: *Master and Fellows, we welcome **Professor Ariel Orellana**, Visiting Fellow*

As **Professor Orellana** steps forward to the Master, the President will say: *Master, I present to you **Professor Ariel Orellana**.*

Professor Orellana will say: *I, **Ariel Orellana**, do solemnly promise and declare that I will faithfully and*

diligently observe the Statutes of this College and maintain so far as in me lies their observance by other members of the College.

The Master will take the hand of the Fellow-Elect and say: *Auctoritate mihi commissa ego, Christopher Greenwood, admitto te **Professor Ariel Orellana** in sodalitium huius Collegii in nomine Patris et Filii et Spiritus Sancti.*

The Master and new Fellow will shake hands.

The new Fellow signs the Order Book, followed by the President.

The President will say: *Master and Fellows, may I ask you to welcome our new colleague.*

Everyone applauds.

The organ then plays while the Master leads the new Fellow out.

The President will lead the Fellows of the College out of Chapel in order of seniority.

The Fellows are invited to greet the newly admitted colleague in First Court and then to join them for coffee in the Parlour
